This evidence-based course prepares participants for professional lactation counseling work. Participants explore technical issues within the context of counseling the mother in the hospital, public health and community settings.

The Lactation Counselor Training Course gives participants the opportunity to take the core competencies, the Lactation Assessment Tool competency, and the didactic exam. A candidate who passes all competencies and the exam will become a Certified Lactation Counselor (CLC), as designated by The Academy of Lactation Policy and Practice (ALPP). The CLC is a national certification.

Accredited as a Nursing Skills Competency Program by the American Nurse Credentialing Center's Commission on Accreditation. RNs who meet the clinical competencies will receive the ANCC Nursing Skills Competency Certificate.

Approved through the Accreditation and Approval Review Committee (AARC) on Education in Human Lactation and Breastfeeding. AARC, jointly sponsored by ILCA and IBLCE, is the formal accreditation and approval body for professional lactation consultant education.
